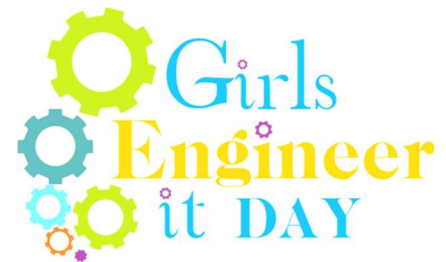

Our big event of the year is upon us!

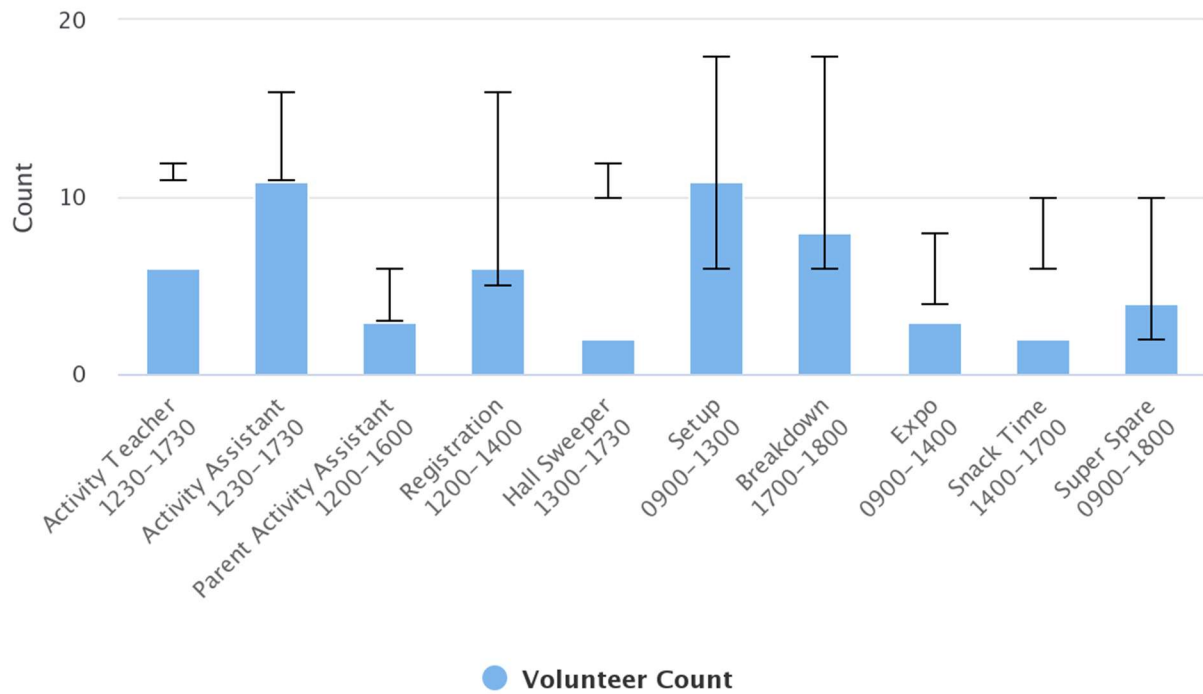
